It was Rotary's largest Asia-Pacific Virtual Conference with 20,000 enrollments. We actually won the 3 awards but it was a democrazy awards night, as PRID described it, They made us a winner in the highest category and runners-up in the other two because "they had to share the awards". The other 2 awards are Best Use of Networking Technology and Best Exhibition Experience. We are also one of the bigger clubs that had 100% members' registration.





