REGISTER NOW FOR WORLD POLIO DAY 2022

World Polio Day 2022 and Beyond: A healthier future for mothers and children, will be held virtually and in-person on 21-22 October in Geneva, Switzerland. The event will highlight the status of polio eradication and address the potential for community-based solutions that go beyond immunizations to enhance the health of mothers and their children.

Following the announcement of Rotary's pledge of an additional US\$150 million toward future polio eradication efforts, Rotary International President Jennifer Jones will join Dr. Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, director-general of the World Health Organization (WHO) in discussing the state of polio eradication and its broader relevance to global health. Register now to attend in-person. (Registration not required to take part virtually)

The recent detections of the poliovirus in New York and UK have increased awareness of the disease's continued threat. Earlier this year, an unvaccinated man in New York was paralyzed and poliovirus was detected in sewage in London. The moment presents an opportunity to highlight the importance of vaccinations as the only form of protection against polio and many other diseases.

At the Geneva event, experts in polio, vaccines and maternal and child health will also discuss the benefits of going "beyond" immunization efforts to invest in the children protected by these

Building on the current investments will ensure that the mothers and children saved from vaccine-preventable diseases can benefit from other preventative and life-saving services, enabling mothers to have a positive experience with their pregnancy and empowering young children to achieve their full potential.

FEDERICO MORALES HIZON

Our guest speaker today is one of the prominent personalities in Philippine mass media today. He is the award-winning news anchor of CNN PHILIPPINES' evening primetime general news program THE FINAL WORD and the weekly business and finance program THE EXCHANGE.

THE FINAL WORD recently won the 26th Asian Television Awards for Best News Anchor and Best News Program.

He is a graduate of the De La Salle University and started his broadcast career at the Manila-based GMA Network, from 1988 to 1995. He was covering capital markets, banking and finance, real estate, investment and corporate developments while in GMA. He anchored the daily business program, Business Today, GMA News Live and Stock Market Live from the trading floor of the Philippine Stock Exchange. His international stint started in 1995 by joining CNBC Asia in Hong Kong.

Before moving back to Manila in 2020 – at the height of the pandemic – he worked as a broadcaster in Hong Kong, Singapore and London for 25 years. He was with the global business and finance network CNBC for 7 and half years and with international news network BBC WORLD NEWS for more than 17 years.

On BBC World News, Rico anchored the business news program, Asia Business Report and general news based show Newsday live

from Singapore and London, every weekday morning.

In his 25 years as an international broadcast journalist, he is the only South East Asian male anchor to work for two of the world's most prestigious global news networks CNBC Business News and BBC World News! When he moved back to the Philippines he joined another powerhouse international news network in CNN Philippines!

Our speaker has interviewed personalities in the financial, political and sporting world from Microsofts Bill Gates and Steve Ballmer, WTO Chief Pascal Lamy, Air Asia's Tony Fernandes, Virgin's Sir Richard Branson, billionaire Warren Buffet, Hedge Fund gurus George Soros, and Mark Mobius, Former US President Bill Clinton, Former Malaysian Prime Minister Mahathir Mohammad, just to name a few.

His anchoring and reportorial responsibilities has also given him the honor to moderate and host several top global events -- The UN Conference on Economic and Social Change in New York. The Clinton Global Initiative in Hong Kong and New York. The World Bank and IMF Annual Meetings, just once more to name some of those prominent Global Event.
