President Adolfo Aran Jr.'s Inaugural Talk July 3, 2023, EDSA Shangrila Hotel



Council of governors, led by District Governor Pope Solis, RC Pasig Charter members, fellow Rotarians, guests, good evening.

During the late 1960s, a young mother was about to give birth in Makati, then part of the province of Rizal, but she couldn't get free medical service. Life was extremely financially difficult for the couple. The father, with borrowed money from relatives, brought her to the Rizal Medical Center, then known as the Rizal Provincial Hospital, and the young mother gave birth to a healthy baby boy. That was me. And here I am, a proud Pasigueno.

Fast forward to year 2000, COVID happened and I found myself delivering food packs at the same hospital. My sponsor, PP Peter John Javier, and I were tasked to provide food deliveries to RMC. Rotary Club of Pasig was one of those early respondents to RMC's call for support during the time when transportation and logistics movement were quite challenging. From March 2000, until September 2000, food delivery to our brave and courageous RMC frontliners

Two years later, with the financial support from Rotarian Flor De Pano, and the able leadership of Service Director Tet Mallare, RCP played Santa Claus to 112 patients a few days before Christmas by giving them P1000 for their Noche Buena as a simple way, albeit difficult time to celebrate Christmas inside the hospital wards. RMC, from the day I was born, until lately, now plays a major role in my "service" and in my "giving back."

My sponsor, PP John, is a fraternity brother from the University of the Philippines, aside from PP Conrad Cuesta and PP Celso Ylagan. Alay Sa Sambayanan and Serve The People were words we uttered upon joining the fraternity and the university's battle cry for the so called "iskolar ng bayan". That's why when he recruited me to join in 2019, he had me at "service above self." And I told him that joining Rotary Club of Pasig was one of the best life decisions I have made. Some examples that made a real impact to the community, include when Doc Jess and Doc Henry Claravall spearheaded the medical mission in Ilugin, the Water Sanitation & Hygiene project lead by Service Director Tet in Pasig public schools, and the LUXID Rotary Microfinance cooperative, now on its 5th year, with the able leadership of PP Conrad Cuesta, to name a few.

Together with the service projects, I experienced the fun fellowship in various dimensions, such as the food crawl in Binondo, a weekend visit to GK Paraiso in Batangas City, dinner with Rotarians with family members in Baguio City, and even the simplest breaking of bread every Thursday lunch time. We discovered the many talents and passions of our fellow Rotarians, PP Bong's culinary prowess, Doc Ato's "that's entertainment" singing and dancing, and Atty Rod's sense of humor, in chat groups and while he devours his Halo Halo in between taking his lunch. We heard it more than once, from invited speakers during our club meetings, like Cory Quirino and Senator Risa Hontiveros and CNN anchor Rico Hizon, speaking in front of RC Pasig members bring them back to the "fun" part of school life, while being in a learning environment.

DID YOU KNOW THAT...

- Rotary's emblem has remained unchanged since 1929
- The blue in the emblem stands for constancy in purpose and the gold for the pure standard upon which rotates the wheel of eternal progress.
- The first motto of RI was “He Profits Most Who Serves Best.”
- The 1989 Council of Legislation established “Service Above Self” as the principal motto of Rotary.
- The Rotary club which first held meetings on a weekly basis as Oakland, California, USA, the 3rd Rotary club.
- The Rotary flag was carried 6,254 feet beneath the earth' surface for a meeting at the bottom of the Quincy Copper Mine.
- The RI Board voted to officially adopt The Four-Way Test in 1943.
- The Rotary world was first organized into “divisions” and was renamed “districts in 1915.
- District 5010 encompasses Canada’s Yukon Territory, The USA's Alaska and Russia's Siberian territory, east of the Ural Mountains measuring 6.5 million square miles.
